



Donation Acceptable Items List

Note: It is very important that items are clean and ready to be priced and shelved. Dirty or broken items will be refused.

The Arc welcomes these items for donation:

- Furniture (unable to accept bunk beds, hide-a-beds, mattresses, cribs or any furniture with rips, tears or stains)
- Antiques and collectibles
- Clothing (clean with no rips or tears)
- Accessories: shoes, purses, belts, scarves, etc.
- Housewares and kitchen items
- Glassware, China, Pottery, full sets of flatware and silverware (without chips or cracks)
- Books and current or collectible magazines
- DVDs, VHS tapes, CDs, record albums
- Electronics (working as originally intended)
- Artwork
- Wheelchairs
- Holiday-themed items (within 1 month of next holiday)
- Non-motorized lawn and garden equipment
- Rugs and linens (clean)
- Craft and office supplies
- Pet supplies

Call first about large items like pool tables, keyboards, etc.

We cannot accept mattresses (including sleeper sofas), cribs, strollers, printers, safety equipment (such as flotation devices or helmets), and entertainment centers.

Due to limited space, we may not be able to accept all offered donations.

Non-Acceptable Donations

- Mattresses, hide-a-beds, sleeper sofas, bunk beds, cribs
- Oversized furniture such as entertainment centers, china hutches, heavy metal
- Appliances such as washer, dryer, refrigerators, freezers
- Console or box-type TVs & Monitors (Flat Screen OK with stand)
- Printers, Fax Machines/Scanners
- Routers
- Cell phones & cordless phones
- Blinds and drapes (window curtains that use metal hook hangers)
- Exercise Equipment such as ellipticals, treadmills, exercise bikes, Nordic track
- Out-of-Season goods such as tents in winter, snow shovels in summer.
- Christmas trees/decorations (except close to the holiday)
- Halloween costumes/decorations (except close to the holiday)
- Baby items such as strollers, beds, highchairs, play pens, car seats
- Kiddie pools, blow up toys and floats
- Anything that needs to be built in, such as toilets, sinks, cabinets
- Electric items that need hard wiring
- Gas-powered equipment of ANY KIND (includes oil lamps)
- Mowers or large motorized outdoor equipment
- Clothes that are dirty, musty, smokey or stained/torn
- Shoes with overly worn soles, dirty or with rips, tears or holes
- Books that are dirty, musty, moldy or have torn covers
- Textbooks with a published date of before 2020
- Ironing boards
- Bed pillows, mattress pads, stained throw pillows
- Beanbag chairs
- Small appliances that are dirty, stained or scratched
- Size-specific sporting goods such as rollerblades, skis/boots, ice skates
- Golf clubs and bags (carbon fiber OK)
- Auto and truck parts such as mats, tire chains, oil, tires, gas, fluids, etc.
- Building materials, including cut glass
- Firearms and ammunition
- Food and beverage (including pet)
- Household chemicals
- Household yard debris
- Medications
- Pianos or organs
- Wall-to-wall carpeting and padding
